Gross Motor Skills		
Runs well and can change directions		
Kicks a rolling ball w/successful contact (3-5)		
Stands on one foot (may be briefly)		
Throws a big ball and catches it

Kneels and squats to adjust height appropriately		
Language Arts Development		
Names a person in a personal drawing		
Uses the pronouns I, you, & me correctly		
Uses some plurals & past tenses		
Traces letters		
Identifies chief body parts (6-8)		
"Writes" with lines and curves		
Recites simple nursery rhymes (2 or 3)		
Recognizes own name		
Identifies some uppercase letters (13-out of order)		
Addresses people by name (teachers, peers)		
Draws a vertical, horizontal, diagonal and curve

Washes & dries hands independently		
Knows full name
