The 19th Annual Clay Shoot benefiting **Y Readers**

EVENT SPONSORSHIP

Morning or Afternoon Sponsor \$12,000

- Secures eight participant spots at the Clay Shoot, recognition at the trophy ceremony, \$500 Carolina Sporting Arms gift cards for each shooter, and eight Sporting Packages that include participation in all gaming stations and door prizes.
