ABOUT OUR SOUTH BOULEVARD COMMUNITY STRENGTHENING

As a commitment to serving the growing Hispanic population in our local community, the Harris YMCA works in partnership with neighboring Hispanic families, local schools, community initiatives and like-minded nonprofits to improve the quality of life for all families across Charlotte's South Boulevard corridor. Our community strengthening efforts include the support of programs like English as a Second Language, Parents as Teachers and Community Workshops. Through a series of seven Community Workshop sessions each year, local families receive valuable support and information focused on healthy living, mental health support, and access to community and school resources.

IMPACT

The Harris YMCA's Krueger Reindeer Romp benefits two critical programs that support Charlotte's South Boulevard community: English as a Second Language (ESL) and Parents as Teachers (PAT). Our ESL program serves approximately **200 participants** annually. PAT provides **25 families** who are under-resourced with access to the education and support they need to help their children develop optimally and prepare for kindergarten.



"My first experience with the Y came through English as a Second Language. The classes taught me to be more confident with my English, and more comfortable interacting with people and my surroundings.

My second experience with the Y came when I joined the Parents as Teachers program. I've learned about child development and where both my kids should be developmentally. I've also gained group connections by interacting with other participants and have been able to get connected with community resources.

PAT and ESL have taught me new things that have made an impact on the way I interact with my children. I am more confident and able to better communicate with them now. I am thankful for the opportunities the Y has provided for my family." – Geydi Paz
