 - Package of 2 - \$25 (Group must include at least one adult)
 - Package of 4 - \$50 (Group must include at least one adult)
- Gellyball – **September and November**
 - Open all afternoon
 - \$10 for unlimited play (\$8 if you bring your own blaster)
- Alpine Tower - **October**
 - Ground School Sessions: 2:15pm, 2:45pm, 3:15pm, 3:45pm
 - Individual - \$15
 - Package of 2 - \$25
 - Package of 4 - \$50
- Riflery – **October**
 - Open all afternoon
 - \$10 for unlimited play

Activity Descriptions

Aerial Adventure Course

Who: Minimum 48" tall, Maximum 250lbs – Sign Up Required!

Meeting Location: EEC Shelter

Info: Enjoy some time up in the trees challenging yourself with various elements as you navigate the Aerial Adventure Course. This experience does not include ziplines. You will need to arrive at the designated start-time for this activity.

Alpine Tower

Who: Minimum 44lbs, Maximum 250lbs – Sign Up Required!

Meeting Location: Weisiger Pavilion

Info: Enjoy some time up in the air challenging yourself as you navigate the Alpine Tower. You will need to arrive at the designated start-time for this activity.

Archery

Restrictions: Minimum 5 years old

Meeting Location: Archery Range off Pool Point Rd

Info: Who will get a bullseye? Come give Archery a try with our compound bows. This is a drop-in activity.

Basketball

Meeting Location: Basketball Courts

Info: Find some friends and play some pick-up ball! This activity is always open. You can bring your own ball or use one of ours.

Disc Golf

Meeting Location: Duke Pavilion

Info: Grab some friends and a few discs and let's see what you've got! This activity is always open. You can bring your own discs or borrow some of ours. Maps and discs are available in the Duke Pavilion.

Fishing

Restrictions: Individuals who are 16 years and older must have a [SC Fishing License](#).

Meeting Location: Waterfront

Info: Individuals who would like to fish need to bring all their own equipment. Please feel free to fish anywhere on our waterfront, if it isn't directly in an activity area. You may not physically enter the water while fishing.

Gaga Ball

Meeting Location: Gaga Pits (Weisiger Pavilion, by Tree Climbing, behind Cabin 24)

Info: Gather a group and enjoy this unique, but addictive, dodgeball style game. Playground balls and game instructions are available in the Duke Pavilion. This activity is always open.

Gellyball

Who: Minimum 5 years old – Sign Up Required!

Meeting Location: Paintball/Gellyball Course (behind & uphill from Archery & Riflery areas)

Info: Get ready for some excitement playing Gellyball – a low-impact game involving blasters and gel orbs! This is a drop-in activity (individuals may need to wait for others to arrive to begin a game).

Paddle Sports

Who: All Welcome

Meeting Location: Paddle Beach

Info: Come cruise around our cove in a kayak, canoe, or paddleboard! This is a drop-in activity, and you can stop by anytime it's open. Please know that paddleboards will only be available in warm weather.

Pickleball

Meeting Location: Tennis Courts

Info: Bring your own equipment or use ours and hit the courts! This activity is always open.

Riflery

Restrictions: Minimum 5 years old – Sign Up Required!

Meeting Location: Riflery Range off Pool Point Rd

Info: Aim and hit targets with precision, in a fun, controlled environment. This is a drop-in activity.

Scavenger Hunts

Info: Pick up one of our scavenger hunt sheets from the front office and see if you can find each item around camp! This activity is always open.

Soccer

Meeting Location: Soccer Field

Info: Bring a ball from home or use one of ours, grab some friends and get a game going! This activity is always open.

Tennis

Meeting Location: Tennis Courts

Info: Bring your own equipment or use ours and hit the courts! This activity is always open.

ThunderBounce

Who: All Welcome

Meeting Location: Blue, Yellow, and Orange Pillow by the Duke Pavilion

Info: Bounce around on the inflatable surface that combines the best aspects of trampolines and bounce houses for endless fun and laughter. This is a drop-in activity, and you can stop by anytime it's open.

Seasonal Activity Descriptions

Giant Slip & Slide

Who: All Welcome

Meeting Location: Duke Pavilion
