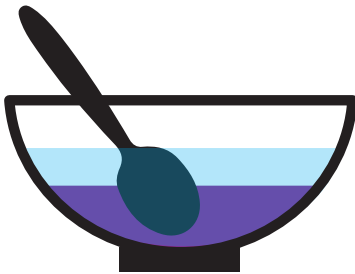


ITEMS NEEDED:

- Balloon
- Glue and Water
- Brush
- 12-16 inches of string or yarn
- Paint and brushes to decorate
- Paper towels or newspaper

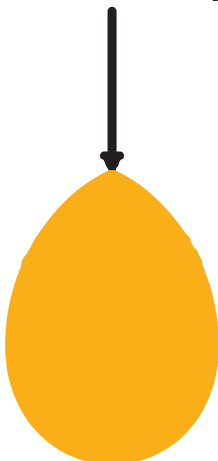

Mix glue with some water in a cup. Use $\frac{1}{2}$ water to $\frac{1}{2}$ glue ratio.



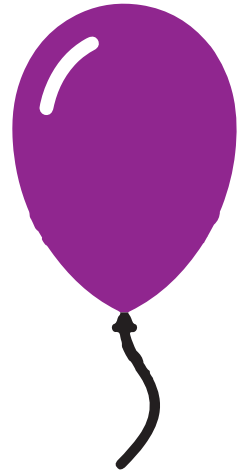

Hang the balloon up by the string to dry until the next day.



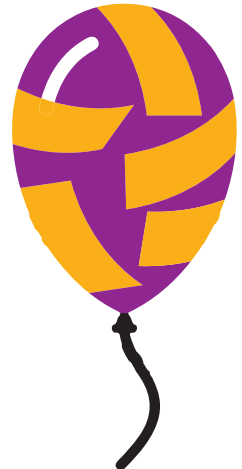

Blow up the balloon, tie a knot and then tie the string to the end of the balloon.

Tear up the paper into smaller sections, lightly brush the balloon with glue and then place the paper on the glue. Continue to lightly brush glue and add paper until you have lots of layers on the balloon. Be sure to leave a small hole in the end where the balloon is tied.

Pop the balloon and pull it out! Then decorate your balloon however you want!
