The following is a summary of our operational safety precautions and procedures, based on the most current guidance from the CDC, North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, and the American Camp Association. These changes may evolve throughout the year as guidance and requirements change.

#### Cabin groups

- Capacity reduced from 22 to 16 (13 campers and 3 staff members per cabin)
- Cabins will do all activities together, remaining socially distant from other groups
- Temperature checks twice per day for all staff and campers and daily symptom questionnaires

#### Food Service

- Meals served cafeteria style with staff plating food for each camper
- Cabins will go through serving lines one at a time
- Tables will be set 8' apart
- Outside seating will be used as needed/appropriate

#### Staffing

- Movement of counselors between cabins during the summer will be minimized
- Leadership staff and MOM volunteers will maintain social distance from groups or use face masks, and Medical Staff will use appropriate PPE while interacting with campers and staff
- Staff will stay with their cabins throughout the day
- Face masks will be required and social distancing will be enforced for staff during time off
- Staff will be encouraged to remain on campus during time off
- Photos will be taken throughout each session and posted on YCampLife on a daily basis

#### Activities

- Cabins will rotate together to all activities with their cabin counselors
- Counselors and campers will help decide, as a cabin, which activities they want to participate in
- High risk activity specialists will supervise from 6 feet away or will wear face masks, when maintaining 6 feet of distance is not possible
- Campfires, talent shows, vespers, and other evening programs will take place outdoors and 6ft will be maintained between cabin groups
- Cabins will have the opportunity to participate in new activities because of the small group sizes and schedule flexibility. Some of these activities include: waterfall hikes, bridge jumping, tent camping, campfire cooking, and beekeeping

#### Disinfecting

- Electrostatic sprayer for cabins and bathrooms
- Cabin bathrooms will be disinfected 3 times a day



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- Handwashing stations will be installed throughout camp
- All equipment will be disinfected between users

#### Check in

- Parents will select time slots to arrive at camp
- Health screening and temperature checks will be conducted for each camper on arrival
- There will be two check-in options:
  - Option 1: For those with medication to drop off or questions for the Camp Directors
    - One parent will enter the Dining Hall with their campers. Camper temperatures will be taken and medication will be dropped off with the medical staff.
  - Option 2: For those who do not have medications to drop off
    - Parents will remain in their vehicles throughout the check-in process
- No parents will be allowed in cabins

#### Check out

- Curbside pickup of campers at cabins
- Luggage will be loaded into vehicles by staff members
- "Drive thru" early enrollment and last minute store purchases
- Parents will remain in vehicles throughout check-out

#### Camp Store

- No care packages can be dropped off at check-in or mailed to camp
  - Care packages can be packed in camper's luggage, but camp staff will not be delivering outside care packages
  - We will have pre-assembled care package options available for purchase from the camp store
  - An order form will be sent prior to camp for those who want to order items from the camp store and have them delivered to campers during their time at camp or those who want to purchase store bucks in advance
  - Store bucks will also be available for purchase and campers will be given an order form to "spend" their store bucks
- We encourage you to send messages to your camper through the YCampLife platform
  - Messages are printed off and delivered to campers on a daily basis
  - Letters are allowed (but sending emails is preferred)
