## **YMCA CAMP HARRISON LIT PROGRAM 2020 PARTICIPANT/PARENT GUIDE**

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. Must be a rising junior in high school.
2. Must possess a keen interest in developing leadership potential.
3. Must have a genuine love for children.
4. Must be willing to grow physically, mentally and spiritually.
5. Must be in good mental and physical health.

### **LENGTH OF STAY AND COST**

LITs must be able to attend all four weeks of the program. The cost for the 2020 CIT program is \$3,500.00. A deposit of \$200 is due with each LIT application. The packet will be considered incomplete without the deposit. If accepted to the LIT program, all balances are due by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM**

The CIT program is designed specifically for rising juniors in high school in order to develop them as future leaders and to help them grow in spirit, mind and body.

The following activities will be included in the CIT program in 2020:

- Team building
- Guest speakers
- Special excursion
- Skills assessments
- Goal Setting
- Service in cabins and activities
- CPR/First Aid certification class

Participation in the LIT program does not guarantee a future spot as a Camp Harrison counselor.

**Please review the following information to familiarize yourself with the LIT application process.**

- A completed LIT Packet will include the following:
  - LIT Application (online)
  - Three reference forms (online)
  - A deposit of \$200
- Your references may be teachers, coaches, counselor, mentors, etc. Please, do not use family members as references. References will need to complete the form, which is available on the Camp Harrison website.
- Once the completed Application and deposit are received by the LIT Director, applicants will be contacted via email to set up an interview.
- All deposits will be processed once the online LIT Application is submitted. Once the selection process is complete, applicants that are not selected will receive a full refund of their deposit.
- LITs will be notified of their acceptance into the program by January 31<sup>st</sup>.
- **LIT Cancellation Policy:** There are many campers that apply for participation in the LIT program. Space is limited. Therefore, cancellation must be made by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Any cancellations after April 1<sup>st</sup> will forfeit all fees.
- **REMAINING BALANCES ARE DUE BY JUNE 1<sup>st</sup>.**
